#### 1. Family Activity: Stop Motion Family Challenge

- Must be between 1 & 2 minutes
- Use Scripture only in your telling of the story, no ad-libbing
- Have fun, the more family members involved the more points

#### 2. Devotional: (2 Corinthians 4:1-22)

- Read through these verses aloud. (If you have young kids, maybe focus on reading 6-13)

  - What does this teach us about God?
  - What does this teach us about Man?
    - Is there a command to obey?
    - Is there an example to follow?
    - Is there a promise to claim?
    - Is there a sin to avoid?
    - Is there a principle to follow?
    - What can I apply personally?
